TO REGISTER A NEW STUDENT YOU MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- **Proof of Residency: One is required. Choose from the following:**
 PG&E (entire two front sheets)
 Water Company
 Cable Company
 Drivers license, phone/cellular bills are not accepted.
- **Proof of immunization** SEE BELOW FOR REQUIREMENTS**
- **Certified copy of or original Birth Certificate**
- **If your child was enrolled in Special Education, bring a current IEP**
- **These completed enrollment forms as found online: Registration Form, Health Inventory, State Reporting Info, Home Language Survey and Records Release documents.**

**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

To enter or transfer into public and private elementary and secondary schools (grades kindergarten through 12) children age 18 years must have immunizations as outlined below.

VACCINE

REQUIRED DOSES

Polio (OPV and/or IPV)

4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement for ages 4-6 if at least one was given on or after the 4th birthday. 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7-17 years if at least one was given on or after the 2nd birthday.

Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis

Age 6 years and under (Pertussis is required)
DTP, DtaP or any combination of DTP or DtaP with DT (tetanus and diphtheria)

5 doses, but... 4 doses meet requirements for ages 4-6 if at least one was on or after the 4th birthday

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)

Kindergarten

2 doses Both on or after 1st birthday – two doses of measles-containing vaccine required. One dose of mumps and rubella containing vaccine required. Students advancing to seventh grade required to have second dose of measles –containing vaccine if not previously obtained.

Hepatitis B

3 doses

Varicella

1 dose Must show 1 dose of Varicella vaccine or verified written proof from doctor that child had chicken pox disease. All students entering California schools for the first time must meet Varicella requirements. Two doses are needed if immunized on or after 13th birthday.
